DOMUS STELLA MARIS




Later in the stay, we met Daniel, Gianluca and Marcello, who are Italian high school students, who had their practice in the hotel's kitchen.




At Domus Stella Maris we celebrated the 18-th birthday of Martina Bogoevska.
